



## ❖ Nike Unlimited Derby

Fill up the sketchbooks, pump some CAD, get your block of aluminum, oil your CNC's and get ready to break all those pesky childhood Pinewood Derby rules at the inaugural Nike Unlimited Derby during this year's 2004 IDSA National Conference.

The challenge is on. Which designer, team or student will walk away with one of the most coveted awards in the design industry? We are looking for across-the-board innovation. It's about speed, materials, form, style and wild interpretations of the rules.

There will be racing, judging and awards; Fastest Car, Best Materials, Best Style, Best Model Making, Best Concept that Lost Big and more. There may even be one or two grudge matches or after hours street races. Download the registration form and be prepared to "run what you brung."

### CAR DESIGN RULES

1. Cars are to be designed as freewheeling, using only gravity as propulsion.
2. Overall car weight unlimited.
3. Overall car length must not exceed 7.5" (190.50mm).
4. Overall car height unlimited.
5. Overall width including wheels 2.75"(69.85mm).
6. Body width at axles 1.75" (44.45mm) (width of lane guides).
7. Track surface and guide strip clearance between the wheels to the underside of the car minimum 0.375" (9.525mm).
8. Competitors will have the opportunity to work on their car(s) between races at pit lane tables.
9. Cars may not be modified after being accepted for technical checks. (Except for emergency repairs such as cheating, collusion or bribery.)
